A student's PRIDE score is a great way to measure soft skills needed to be successful in the workplace.

The PRIDE score is based on a 4 point scale and therefore is similar to a GPA. By combining the grade point average PLAN, WorkKeys, ACT, and PRIDE score each student has an opportunity to show how they have become college, career, and life ready at West Ottawa High School. It is our hope that local employers will recognize the PRIDE score as a measure for determining the quality of job applicants coming from West Ottawa High School.
